4. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 22nd October 2026**.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by midnight on **Tuesday, 6th October 2026** Applications can be made online at: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
6. Electors should take note that applications to vote by **POST** or requests to change or cancel an existing application must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at by **5 p.m. on Wednesday, 7th October 2026**.
7. Applications to vote by **PROXY** must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5 p.m. on Wednesday, 14th October 2026**.
8. Applications to vote by **emergency PROXY** on the grounds of medical incapacity, or if your occupation, service or employment means you cannot go to a polling station after the above deadlines must be made by **5.00 pm on POLLING DAY**

- Your nomination paper must be submitted as an attachment, PDF, JPEG, Word Document would be preferred.
